- Meet with residents to assess needs, set goals, and develop service plans.
- Coordinate services such as healthcare, legal aid, education, and employment support.
- Maintain accurate case notes, progress reports, and discharge documentation.
- Facilitate communication with community providers and legal partners.
- Participate in care team meetings and contribute to holistic program planning.
- Build and maintain a network of trusted community resources.
- Serve as a supportive advocate and ambassador of the ministry's mission.
